

FRENCH PROVINCIAL FAÏENCE QUIMPER



HB/Henriot Quimper, a name known wherever pottery is prized, is still made today in the town of Quimper in the province of Brittany, France. Each piece is fully and individually hand painted, initialed by the artist and signed and signed HE HERRIOT mark.

Among the numerous designs produced, we feature those which reflect the diversity of decors created by Quimper artisans. Flowers, decors created by Quimper artisans. Flowers, cocks, birds and particularly the peasant figures, in their curious high lace coits and baggy pantaloons, capture the charm of life in Brittany. Henriot (created in 1898) - broad dark blue bands and a sunny yellow border encircle the naive figures dressed in gay colors, on a background of white glaze. Mistral - a design in green and rose creates a floral border, accented with hexing, surrounding a Breton figure on a soft blue glaze. Soleil - sunny, bright yellow fleuri Royal - array of flowers in pastel colors on a soft blue background individually created and designed by the artist. Tradition - a vibrant and detailed floral garland encompasses the colorfully painted Breton couple. Champêtre - captures the essence of French country life with the cockerel, masterful symbol of France, decorated in bold colors on a white glaze.


HISTORY

Quimper, the quaint, old world, gray granite town is dominated by the ancient Cathedral of St. Corentin built in the 15th century. Bordering the Odet River and near the center of town stands the old pottery factory. Traditions of pottery making in Quimper go back as far as Gallo-Roman times. However, Jean Baptiste Bousquet is credited as being the founder of the pottery industry, since it was he who in 1690 first hired other artisans to form a factory. Two important surviving factories, Henriot and Grande Maison HB, merged in 1968 to form the HB/Henriot factory of today.

HB/Henriot Quimper faience has been improved without losing its character. The texture of the finish is smoother and shapes more uniform, yet the brilliant colors are still hand mixed and hand painted, thus each piece is individual with slight differences in decoration. Even the glazing technique is done by hand creating an uneven finish, and small pinholes here and there, which is a characteristic of the peasantware.

The history, character, and alluring patterns of the HB/Henriot pottery make this a truly unique French country earthenware perfectly suited for formal or informal dining and decorating. Of the many patterns produced by this famous faiencerie, the traditional patterns have stood the test of time and have a charming, old world influence on the user. Quimper will bring joy to your home for many years.






"WALLPLATES"






